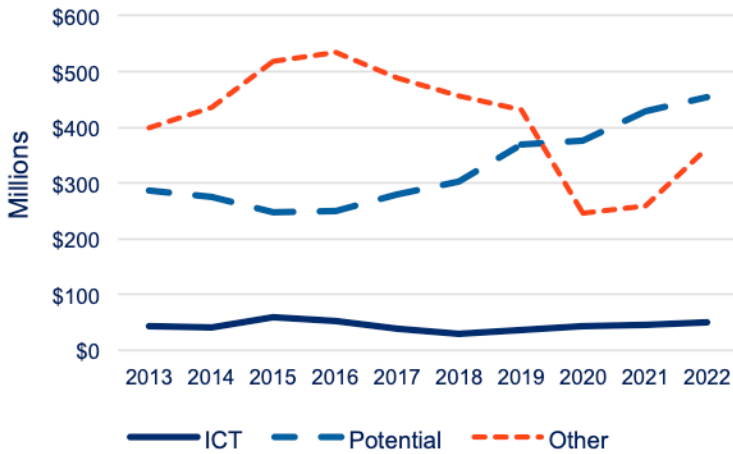




# Texas' 16th and Digital Trade

TX-16 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$44 million in 2013 to \$50 million in 2022 (14%), supporting 71 direct and 134 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$286 million to \$454 million (59%), supporting 1,368 direct and 980 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$400 million in 2013 to \$432 million in 2019 (8%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

**Texas' 16th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 1,439 direct and 1,115 indirect American jobs in 2022.**

Europe was Texas' 16th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Texas' 16th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Netherlands grew from \$12 million in 2013 to \$32 million (+167%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$170 million out of Texas' 16th district's \$505 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Miscellaneous computer services are the top ICT services export, but fell from \$28 million in 2013 to \$23 million in 2022 (-17%).

Royalties from industrial processes are Texas' 16th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$98 million in 2013 to \$195 million in 2022 (99%).
