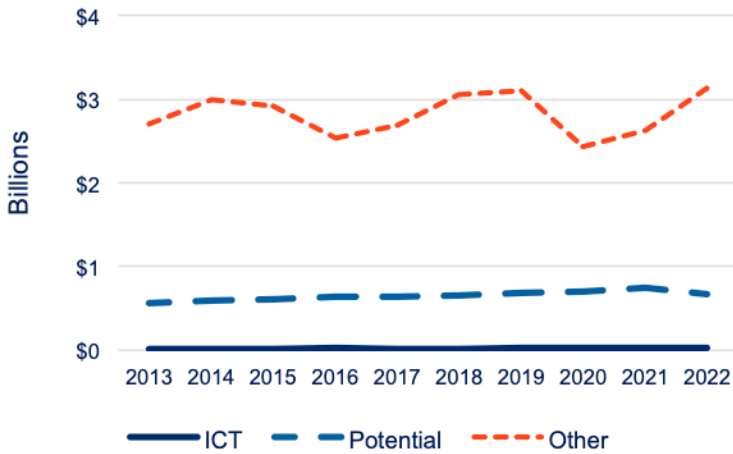




Texas' 29th and Digital Trade

TX-29 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$16 million in 2013 to \$23 million in 2022 (51%), supporting 69 direct and 49 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$561 million to \$667 million (19%), supporting 2,065 direct and 1,452 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$2.7 billion in 2013 to \$3.1 billion in 2019 (15%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have since fully recovered.

Texas' 29th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 2,134 direct and 1,501 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Texas' 29th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Texas' 29th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Ireland grew from \$49 million in 2013 to \$107 million (+121%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$219 million out of Texas' 29th district's \$691 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$9.9 million in 2013 to \$20 million in 2022 (99%).

Business management and consulting services are Texas' 29th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$99 million in 2013 to \$219 million in 2022 (121%).
