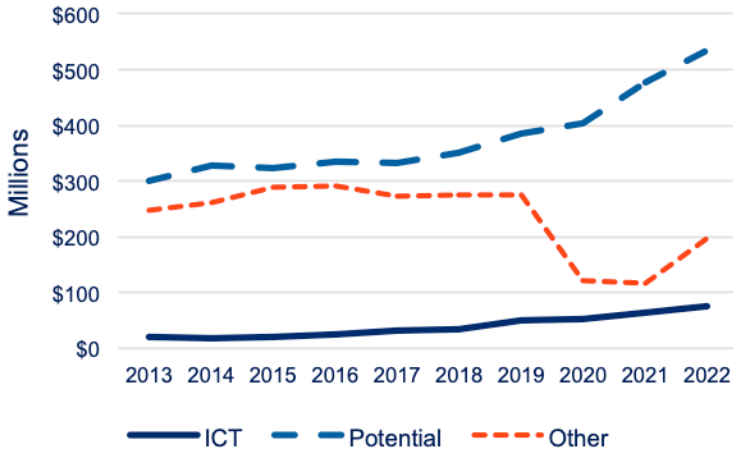




# Texas' 31st and Digital Trade

TX-31 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$21 million in 2013 to \$75 million in 2022 (260%), supporting 233 direct and 164 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$300 million to \$535 million (78%), supporting 1,749 direct and 1,090 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$247 million in 2013 to \$275 million in 2019 (11%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

**Texas' 31st district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 1,982 direct and 1,254 indirect American jobs in 2022.**

Europe was Texas' 31st district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Texas' 31st district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Ireland grew from \$24 million in 2013 to \$89 million (+270%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$212 million out of Texas' 31st district's \$610 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$7.3 million in 2013 to \$66 million in 2022 (813%).

Business management and consulting services are Texas' 31st district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$52 million in 2013 to \$191 million in 2022 (265%).
