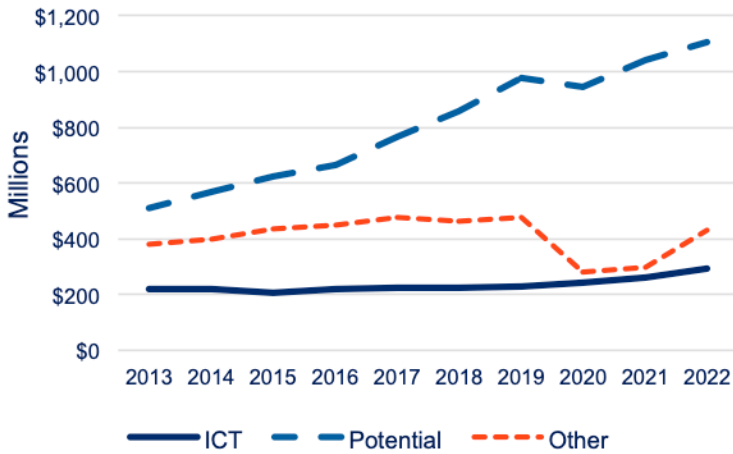




# Utah's 1st and Digital Trade

UT-1 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$218 million in 2013 to \$294 million in 2022 (35%), supporting 511 direct and 489 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$510 million to \$1.1 billion (117%), supporting 3,200 direct and 1,873 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$380 million in 2013 to \$477 million in 2019 (26%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

**Utah's 1st district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 3,711 direct and 2,362 indirect American jobs in 2022.**

Europe was Utah's 1st district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Utah's 1st district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Ireland grew from \$30 million in 2013 to \$131 million (+331%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$535 million out of Utah's 1st district's \$1.4 billion in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Royalties from computer software are the top ICT services export, growing from \$171 million in 2013 to \$191 million in 2022 (12%).

Credit-related services are Utah's 1st district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$85 million in 2013 to \$182 million in 2022 (115%).
