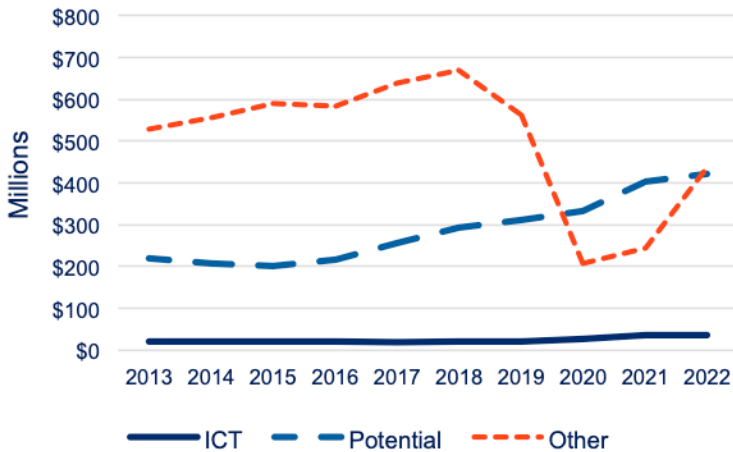




Washington's 5th and Digital Trade

WA-5 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$20 million in 2013 to \$37 million in 2022 (87%), supporting 108 direct and 85 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$221 million to \$423 million (91%), supporting 1,348 direct and 892 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$529 million in 2013 to \$563 million in 2019 (6%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Washington's 5th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 1,456 direct and 977 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Washington's 5th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Washington's 5th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Switzerland grew from \$15 million in 2013 to \$40 million (+160%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$181 million out of Washington's 5th district's \$460 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$7.5 million in 2013 to \$29 million in 2022 (290%).

Business management and consulting services are Washington's 5th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$19 million in 2013 to \$120 million in 2022 (537%).
